Updates from the RI Board meeting

At its September meeting, the RI Board weighed in on several topics related to New Generations:

- Rotaract policies were amended to give Rotaract clubs flexibility in meeting options, including opportunities to meet online. (Updated versions of the Rotary Code of Policies and Standard Rotaract Club Constitution and Bylaws will be posted online soon.)
- The Board agreed that a “one Rotary” alumni approach is consistent with the RI Strategic Plan. A joint RI/Rotary Foundation alumni function would recognize all Rotary program participants and facilitate information-gathering about alumni while still differentiating the groups by program.
- The Board adopted specific guidelines — titled “New Generations Are the Future of Rotary” — to help Rotary clubs more effectively attract and engage young professionals.
