2012 will be assessed with a 10% surcharge for every month thereafter.

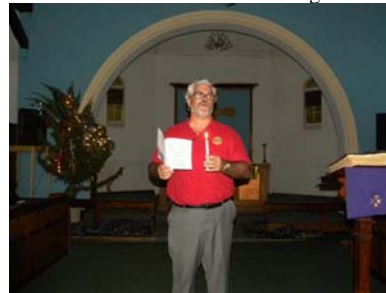
Rotary Santa's
